

Update on the IE component of ST505.

See the original posting describing the IE project. This modifies the timetable.

- A report of at 2- 3 pages (can be more), common for the group, will be handed in by Fri., Nov. 9. This will provide general background and discussion of the problem (no statistical analyses). This will become part of the final report, with changes as needed.
- Complete initial exploring of data by Friday. Nov 16 (not to be handed in).
- Draft of statistical analyses: completed by Friday Nov. 30.
- Presentations during week of Dec. 3. This will include quick background, basic results and conclusions. These will be set up over two evenings. You need to come on the evening your group is presenting. ST505 student will not need to go to class two days that week.
- Full reports due by Sat. Dec 15 (the last day of exams) at the latest. You should be able to finish earlier but this will give you flexibility depending on your exam schedule. While the background and statistical analysis (including statistical conclusions) will be common to the group, the last couple of pages of the report, in which you will discuss what you have learned about the problem, must be done individually.
